- **u** Turn on the Power Strip
- **u** Turn on the lower amplifier.



□ Turn on the HDM remote and press button #1 (Make sure the remote is aimed at the audio equipment).

You will not see anything on the remore but look at the box above the power strip and see if the light is on and the #1 light is on.



□ Turn on the projector with the remote (note is may take a few seconds to turn on. If on you will see the first two blue lights showing, the first light is always on.)
